

# Kentucky State Senate Bill 34 What it will Mean to Pregnant and Single Mothers

With the overturning of Roe v. Wade, support for pregnant women and single mothers is vitally important. There is currently a bill before the Kentucky State Senate, Senate Bill 34, that will provide much needed support for pregnant women and single mothers. Within that bill are supports in the form of medical care, food, housing assistance, tuition, and more. Of particular interest is child-care. Child-care is one area in which many single mothers struggle. Finding child-care, paying for child-care, what to do with their child if child-care is closed and mom has to work, are issues we see daily with our program participants.



# Marvelous Works

Oh, what marvelous work the Lord has done at Lifehouse Maternity Home in 2023! As Lifehouse moves into 2024, we celebrate the births of five precious babies in 2023, bringing the total number of babies born to Lifehouse moms since opening our doors in 2008 to 95! In 2023 we welcomed 26 moms and 20 babies to Lifehouse. Lifehouse provided resources to 304 women, up nearly 34% over 2022, and our occupancy nearly doubled in 2023. For most of the year we were at or near capacity, with a waiting list.

In 2023, Lifehouse had four participants enrolled in college and three working toward their GED. All program participants are required to work, participate in weekly Bible study, attend church, meet with a counselor, work with our Case Manager on goals, attend a recovery program if they have a history of drug use, and complete life skills assignments weekly. We have had participants working on securing driver's licenses and learning English as their second language.

#### Lifehouse sees a disturbing trend

Lifehouse continues to see a disturbing trend with an increasing number of women escaping domestic violence, being trafficked, or at risk of being trafficked. In 2023, we saw a 33% increase in the number of women fleeing domestic violence, and a 78% increase in the number of women who were or were at risk of being trafficked.

Here is a breakdown of 2023:

Fleeing domestic violence	70%	<ul> <li>Physical, emotional or sexual abuse</li> </ul>	90%

The fact that Lifehouse Maternity Home exists, and is a resource for pregnant and parenting women is marvelous in our eyes. Lifehouse is providing a safe home, food, and clothing, as well as guidance, help, and care for hundreds of women each year. It is marvelous that our supporters continue to see Lifehouse as a vital need in the Louisville community, providing financial and other resources that allows us to serve a vulnerable and underserved population.






