

# Kentucky Attorney General Visits Lifehouse

Lifehouse was pleased to welcome
Kentucky Attorney General, Russell
Coleman for a tour of Lifehouse. The
Attorney General and Rewa Zakharia,
the Criminal Chief and a member of
the Executive Staff learned about how
Lifehouse is serving pregnant and
parenting women and children in crisis.

The Attorney General is passionate about addressing the problem of domestic violence, and the staff of Lifehouse were able to share stories of women who found safety and help through Lifehouse and how our program is changing lives. In 2024, 60 percent of the women served by Lifehouse had experienced domestic violence and 50% had been trafficked.

The Attorney General was very impressed with all the Lifehouse is doing to make a difference in the lives of women and



children seeking security, safety and a new start. He commended the staff on their work and encouraged Lifehouse to reach out to his office if we need assistance. Lifehouse is grateful for the time the Attorney General spent with us, and the work he and his staff are doing to make a difference in Kentucky.

# You are the LIFE of Lifehouse

Thank you! Two simple words that I feel can never express my deep gratitude for your support of Lifehouse. Quite simply, there would not be a Lifehouse without YOU!

You are the UFE-line for the women who call us crying, desperate to escape the man that is hurting them, afraid he will turn on her child next. You are the LIFE-line for the woman who is pregnant, fearing what her trafficker will do when he finds out. You are the LIFE-line for the mom who arrived in this country as a minor, abused along the long trek to freedom and now finds herself with two toddlers under three, anxious to begin working to pay off the coyote threatening her family back in her home country. You are the LIFE-line for the woman who is finally sober after years of addiction, who was assaulted but has made the decision of life for her unborn child. You are the LIFE-line for the woman

who is tired of the lies from her family and friends and shuffling herself and her child from couch to couch, yearning for a place to call home. You are the LIFE-line for the woman who has been sleeping in her car with her baby but ended up in an accident that totaled her only shelter.

#### Finding Life at Lifehouse

Because of your generosity and prayers, women who chose LIFE have found LIFE at Lifehouse. Each time we hear another story like the ones above, I not only pray for the woman and her child or children, but I pray that those who support us will continue, so that Lifehouse will be where these women will find hope, healing and a safe place to thrive. Your partnership is our greatest asset, and without you, without Lifehouse, many women and children would not find the safety and security they need.

#### **Providing Hope and Healing**

We know that there is only One who can fill the God-size hole in these women's hearts, and Lifehouse is here to help them learn about God's plan for them and their children, and what a Man named Jesus did for them. Along the way we teach them parenting and life skills, help them secure employment, connect them with therapy and recovery programs, and guide them to achieving their goals. Lifehouse does this over the course of four years, if needed, understanding that complex trauma needs more than just a short-term solution in order for a woman to make a lasting change in her life.

Whenever Lifehouse has experienced a need, you have shown up to meet it. My simple two-word THANK YOU will never be enough, but it comes with sincerity and appreciation far more than I can express. May God bless you and keep you, may His face shine upon you and give you peace.

#### **Budgeting Workbook**

During the month of November, our participants attended a financial empowerment session hosted by Jose, a branch leader at **Truist Bank**. The session aimed to provide principles of basic banking, budgeting, and establishing credit. Jose provided participants with a practical workbook to retain the information and helpful tools to apply when managing their finances. The participants seemed to appreciate the open discussion format for asking questions and learning about Jose's experiences.

#### Participant Recognized

At Lifehouse, we are intentional about showing participants that we are rooting for them and that we see their BIG efforts. One way we recognize participants is through nominating one participant each month to be titled "Participant of the Month." The participant selected for December was D.R. She is commended for her tremendous growth and resilient personality, which has helped her overcome many challenges. She is a very engaged and patient mother to her two small children and is quick to offer a helping hand when others are in need.





#### Quilt Donation Brings Warmth for Body and Soul

Lifehouse received a beautiful assortment of decorated quilts presented by the Coat of Many Colors Quilters Group from First Baptist Church Fisherville. Quilters joined Lifehouse on Oct. 23 to present the handmade quilts. These quilts will truly be helpful to our women and infants as the colder months approach. Ladies in our program often utilize public transportation, so keeping children warm is essential.

#### Career Planning

One area in which we empower women on their Lifepath journey is guiding them to pursue their desired career pathways. In the previous months, this has meant spending one-on-one time with Phase 1 participants, learning about their career interests, creating chronological resumes, and connecting them to online job portals. For our Phase 2 participants who have chosen career paths, we discuss time management strategies, handling difficult situations in the workplace, and working through daily stressors.

- Support them with your time. Many pregnancy help organizations, Lifehouse included, receive donations of material goods that need sorting and organizing. Some offer special programs for women and help with babysitting is needed so moms can attend programs. Lifehouse needs babysitters to help during Monday night Bible study. Maybe there is a need for handyman services or cleaning? Lifehouse would like to begin a meal train for Mondays to help our women before evening Bible study. Pregnancy help organizations always need help with fundraising events. Our annual golf scramble needs a variety of help from pre-planning to day-of event volunteers.
- Provide your talent. Pregnancy help organizations, including Lifehouse, often need board members to help with fiduciary and governance oversight. If you have a background in finance, accounting, law, marketing, business, or just have a heart for the pro-life movement, I know we can find a place for you on our Board of Directors. Maybe you have a gift for leading Bible study. We would love to have you as one of our leaders for a one time or recurring study.
- Tell others about Lifehouse! We hear all the time, "I had no idea this was in Louisville." Let other people know about Lifehouse. Encourage them to come to for a tour, or even better, come and bring them with you.
- ▼ Talk about Lifehouse to your pastor, church mission committee, small group, men's or women's group, Respect Life committee, outreach committee, community organization, networking group, and any other organization for which you are a part. Bring your pastor for a tour. Invite our Executive Director to speak to one of these groups.

- Give gift cards. Gifts cards of \$5 and up are used for participant rewards as a part of our Earn While You Learn program. This program allows our participants to earn "Lifehouse bucks" for completing assignments related to parenting, life skills, education, and more. You can also donate gently used household goods, such as small appliances, dishes, glassware, silverware, and pots and pans. All must be very clean and in working order to be placed in our Earn While You Learn program.
- And speaking of gift cards, Kroger gift cards are a great way to help Lifehouse meet its need for fresh meat, fresh produce, frozen items and other perishable food. Kroger gift cards help us stretch our food budget impacted by the loss of a perishable food supplier resource.
- Please consider giving financial support monthly. Regular monthly support really helps Lifehouse and all pregnancy help organizations manage their budget and anticipate income. You can easily set up recurring giving on our website, www.LifehouseLouisville.org, by credit

# From Homeless to Hopeful:

"The Lord you God, who is going before you, will fight for you,...before your very eyes."

- Deuteronomy 1:30

At Lifehouse we believe the Lord is fighting for us. Not just our organization, but for each woman and child that comes through our doors. 2024 is no exception. Our organization faced its own share of challenges, we recognize many of them to be spiritual battles, as often happens when so much good is being accomplished in the name of God.

For our participants, many who have faced a lifetime of battles, coming to Lifehouse was the point in which a shield of protection was raised, and where a team came together to battle for them. We are often asked by those we serve, "why are you doing this for me?"

For someone for whom love always had a condition or is never truly present, simple acts of kindness, service and support are a very foreign concept. Building trust and providing a sense of safety and security are what we do for these women and children.

The battles faced by the courageous women who became a part of the Lifehouse family in 2024 include:

- 60% fleeing domestic violence
- 50% trafficked
- 30% spent time in foster care
- 70% addiction or drug use
- 70% physical, emotional or sexual abuse
- 60% eating disorder or food insecurity
- 100% mental health diagnosis or trauma
- 100% homeless or housing insecure

Lifehouse was thrilled to welcome babies #96 and #97 in 2024. We are growing more excited as we get closer to seeing baby #100! In addition to these new lives, Lifehouse serves many





women who already have children. In 2024, sixteen moms and 15 children called Lifehouse home. Additionally, Lifehouse provided resources to 288 women. We continue to serve women from throughout Kentucky, the United States, and even internationally, from countries such as Cuba, Mexico, and Honduras.

Through the support of our Program Director and Case Manager, Lifehouse moms were connected to vital resources to help them apply for college classes, secure a driver's license, find employment and daycare, register for their GED, obtain mental health counseling, attend addiction recovery programs, and begin working on U.S. residency and work permits.






# Income 2024


# **Expenses 2024**

#### Other ways to help Lifehouse:

- Add Lifehouse as beneficiary on your life insurance policy.
